

On February 24, 2010, Delegate Tom Louisos will introduce a motion to bring HJR 10 directly out of the Constitutional Revision Committee to the floor of the House of Delegates, for an up-or-down vote. This bill, a constitutional amendment, says: *“Nothing in this Constitution secures or protects a right to abortion or requires the funding of an abortion.”* Every year, this bill dies in committee without consideration. If passed, this bill will allow our state to stop paying for abortions with tax dollars, and it will allow us, when the U.S. Supreme Court’s *Roe v Wade* decision is overturned, to stop abortions in West Virginia. On February 24, every member of the House of Delegates will be able to vote yes or no on HJR 10. Procedural motions will be offered, to kill the bill. Delegates will vote on those procedural motions.
